We are doing this to provide students with the skills to resolve conflicts and improve their overall well being at school.



Throughout the year, we will be:

1. Explicitly teaching students conflict resolution skills.
2. Giving staff and students a common language to discuss conflicts using a problem solving wheel.
3. Using restorative practices to help students build and repair relationships and demonstrate empathy toward others.



Community/Home Connections
